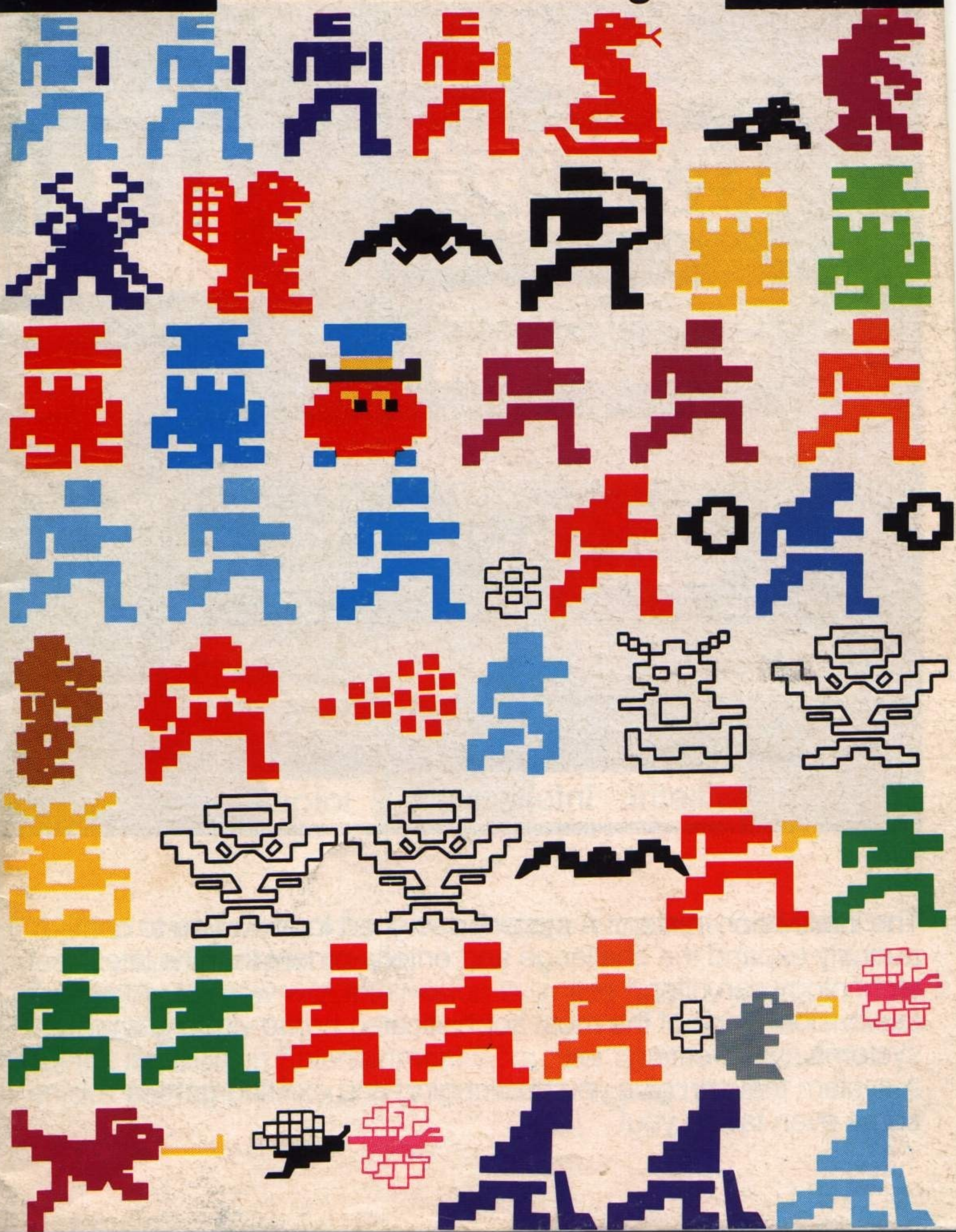

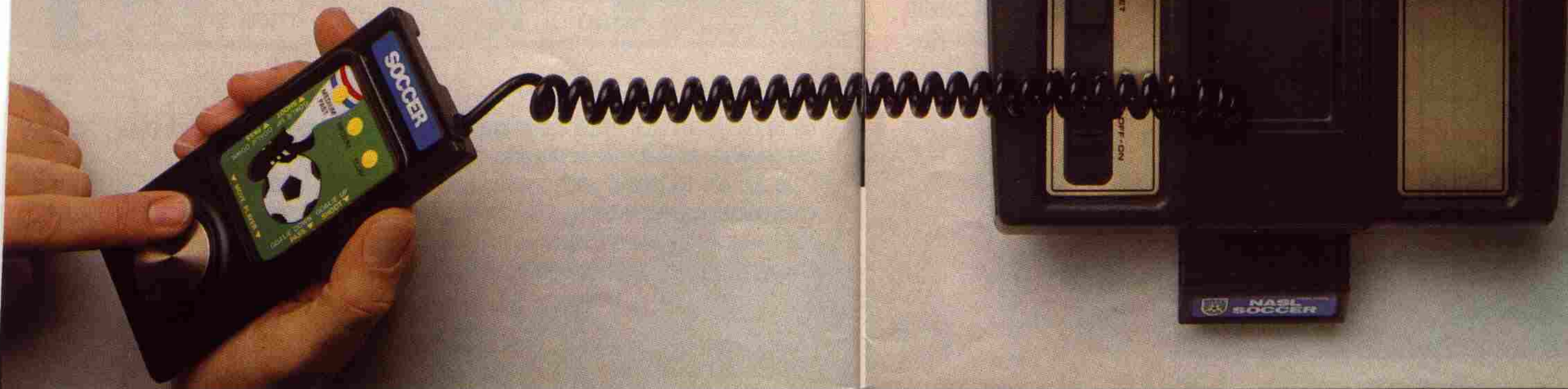

BURGERTIME™. 4549

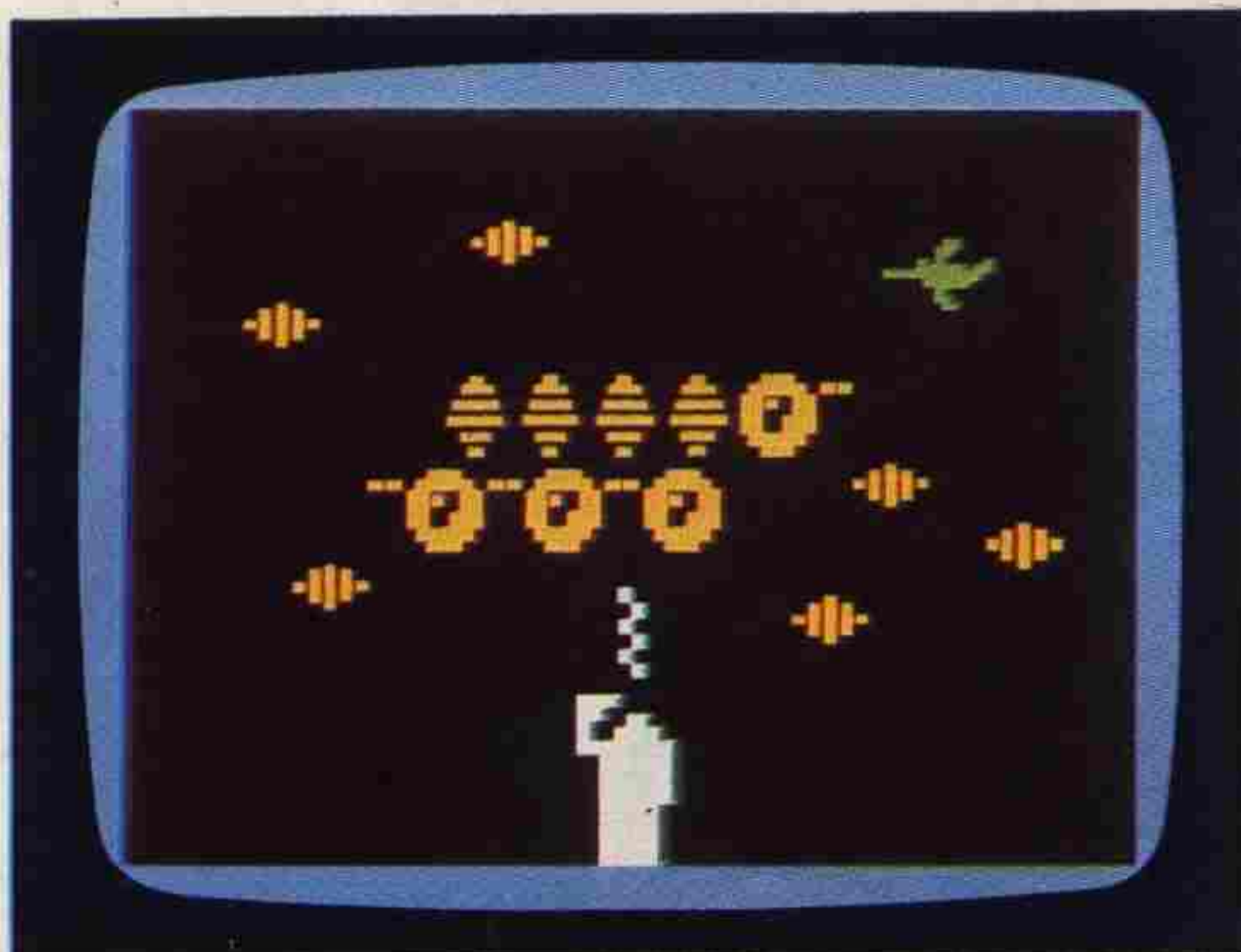

beef patties, lettuce and buns, or knock them out with pepper. Build four hamburgers and you're on to the next level – it's fast fun with fast food!



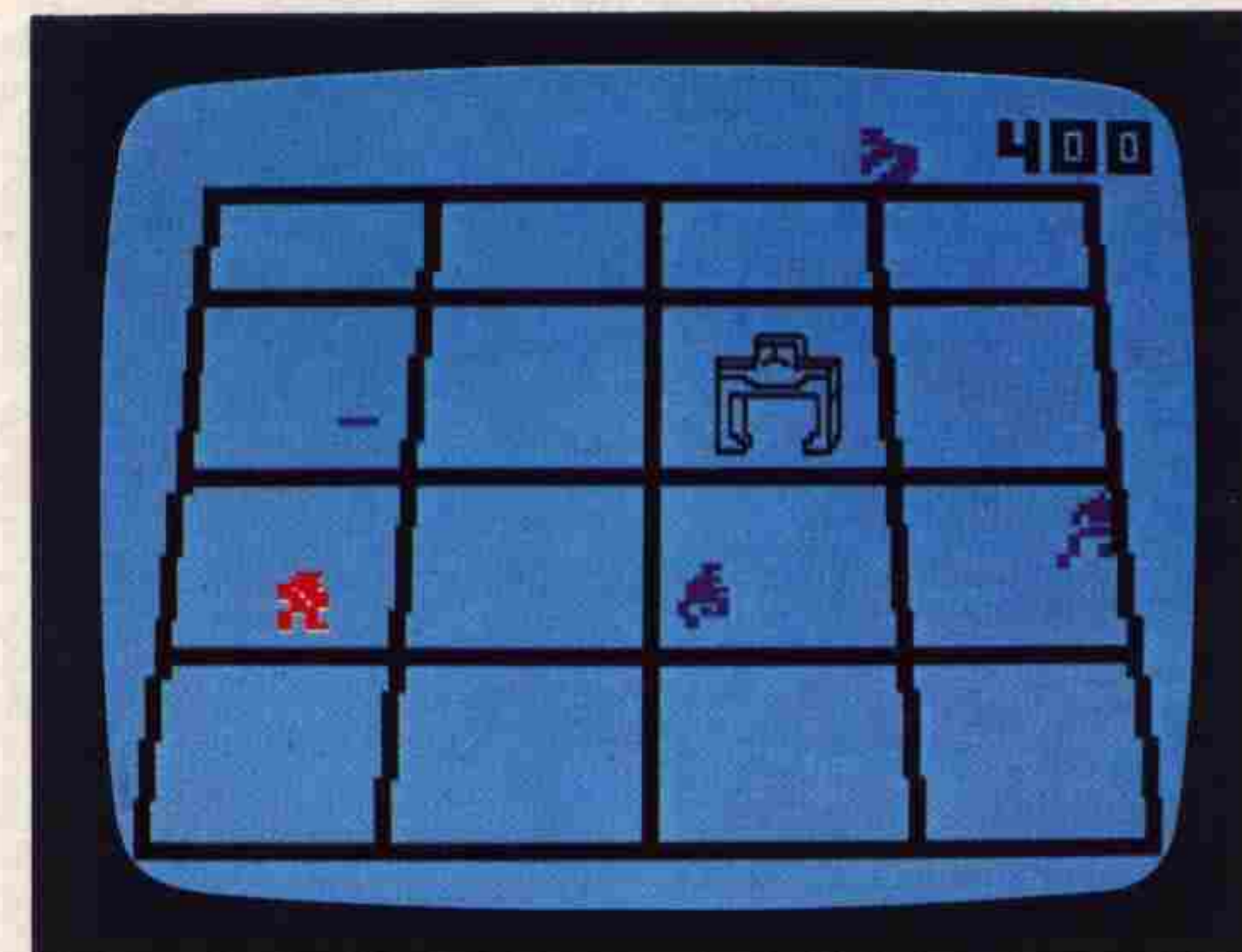
BUZZ BOMBERS™. 4436

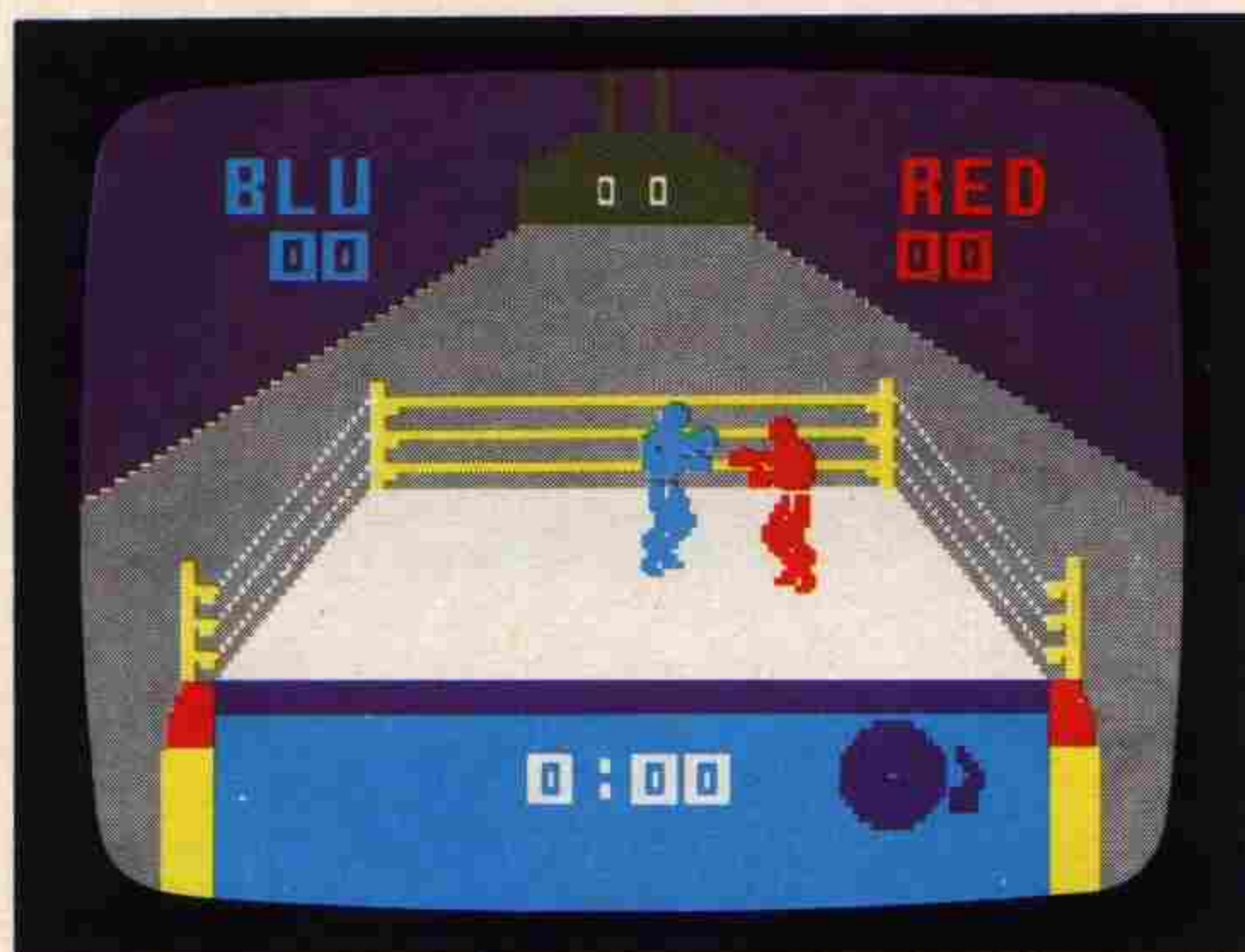
SKIING. 1817

computer caddie keeps score. Who'll be first to hole-in-one?

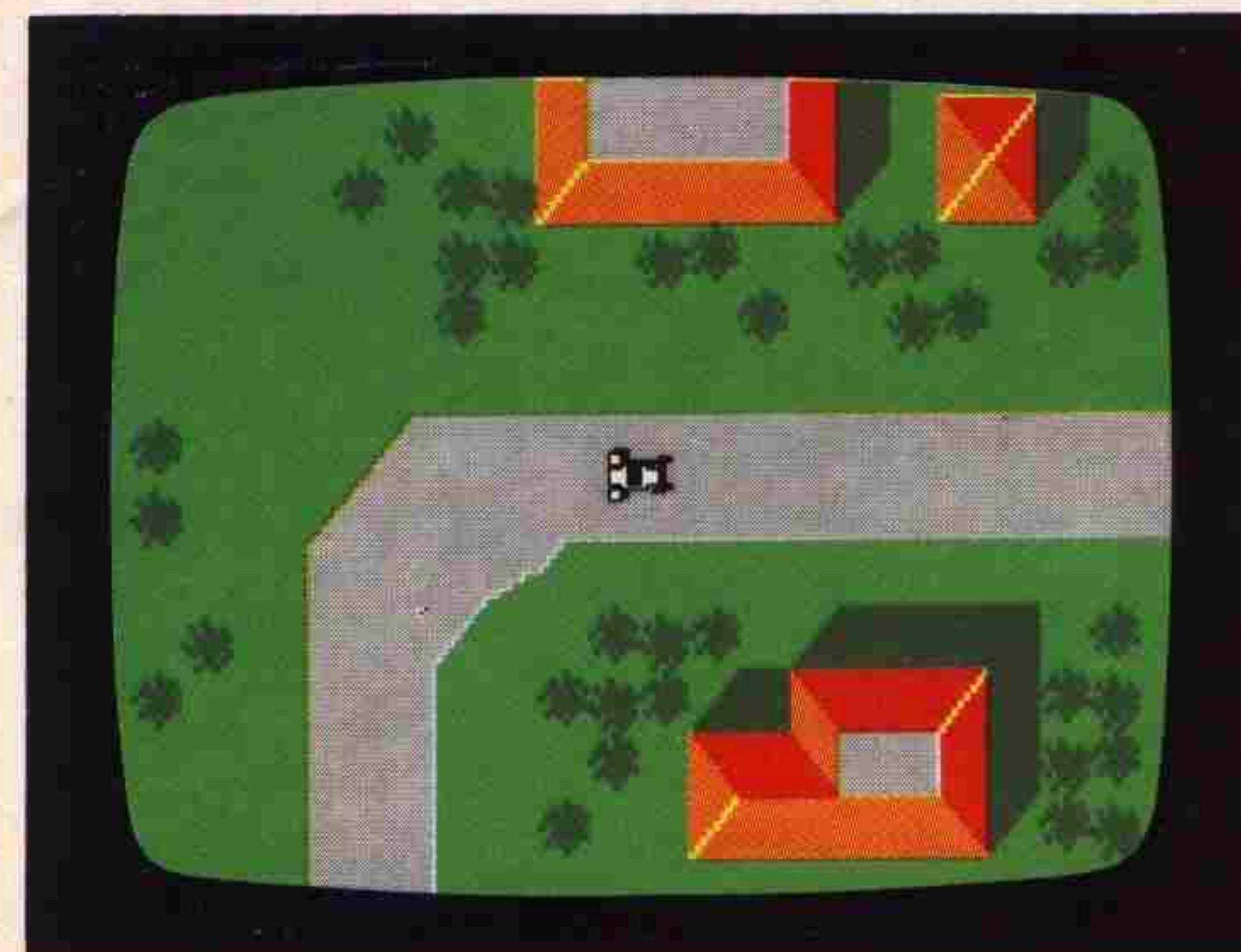
BOWLING. 3333

DRAUGHTS. 1120

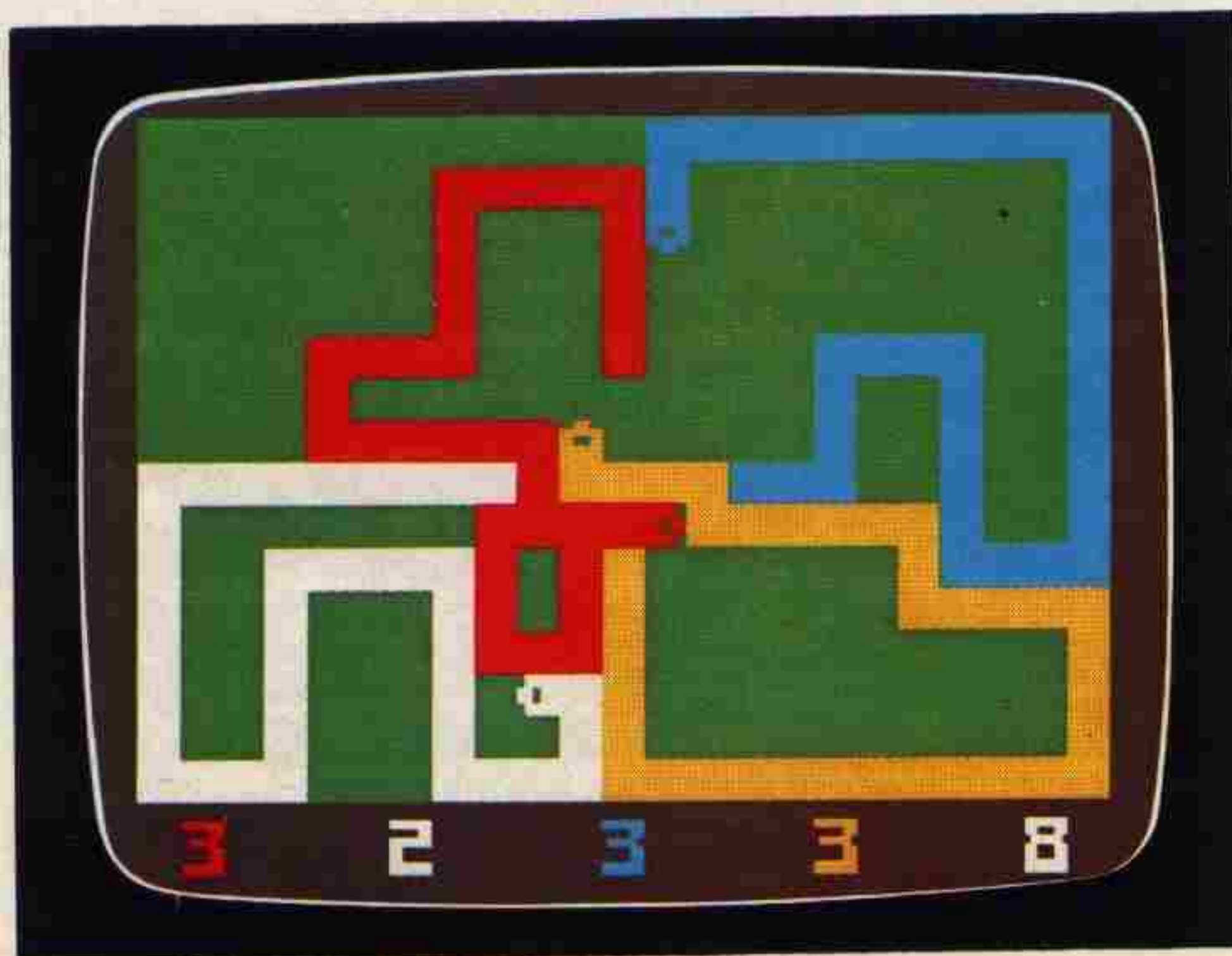
